Established in 2019 and registered under the Non-Governmental Organizations' Act, 2002 with Registration Certificate No. 00NGO/R/0251, FADev operates across mainland Tanzania with a mission to promote a responsible, inclusive, and sustainable ASM sector.

Since its inception, FADev has implemented a range of impactful initiatives aimed at:

- Supporting the formalisation and legalisation of ASM operations;
- Promoting environmentally and socially responsible mining practices; and
- Enhancing the meaningful participation of women in ASM value chains.

POSITION OVERVIEW

The Executive Secretary (ES) serves as the Chief Executive Officer of FADev and reports directly to the Governing Council. The ES is responsible for overall leadership, strategic direction, programme delivery, stakeholder engagement, and operational excellence across the organisation. The successful candidate will possess a strong understanding of the ASM sector, policy frameworks, and the socio-economic dynamics influencing its development.

Key Responsibilities:

- Provide visionary leadership aligned with FADeV's mission and strategic objectives;
- Oversee the design, implementation, monitoring, and evaluation of all programmes and projects;
- Cultivate and manage partnerships with development partners, government institutions, mining associations, NGOs, and community-based organisations;
- Represent FADeV at national and international forums, advocating for the recognition, and needs of small-scale miners;
- Lead resource mobilisation efforts, including proposal development, donor engagement, and reporting;
- Ensure strong institutional governance, financial stewardship, and regulatory compliance;
- Recruit, lead, and inspire a multidisciplinary team while fostering an inclusive and results-oriented organisational culture; and
- Report to the Governing Council and Annual General Meeting, supporting all governance and compliance processes

- Strong leadership, fundraising, and strategic planning abilities;

- Excellent communication, advocacy, and interpersonal skills; and
- Fluency in English and Kiswahili.
